Who Can Enter

- 1. To be eligible to participate in the contest, entrants must be Georgia residents.
- 2. Participants must be between K and fifth grade school age.

How to Enter

Enter by dropping off a physical copy of your book at any Gwinnett County Public Library location. Entries must include either an attached submission form, which can be found on the Gwinnett County Public Library website, or have an accompanying online submission form filled out, also on the GCPL website. The submission window will close at 11:55pm on Wednesday, January 13, 2021.

The Prize

- 1. One (1) first place winner will be selected. The winner will have his or her book added into the Gwinnett COunty Public Library collection, as well as have his or her book made into an ebook. All other entries will only be made into an ebook.
- 2. The winner will be contacted by the contact information given on his or her submission form.
- 3. In accepting the title as first place winner, you acknowledge that Gwinnett County Public Library has the right to publicize your name, character, likeness, photograph, voice and the fact that you are the winner for promotional purposes without financial remuneration.

Contest Rules

- 1. Entries will only be accepted from 12am on December 14, 2020 through 11:55pm on January 13, 2021.
- 2. All entries must have an accompanying submission form, either online or a physical copy.
- 3. One (1) submission allowed per person.
- 4. All entries will be judged by Peachtree Corners Library staff members in four categories.
- 5. Entries may not include profranity, racism, racial slurs, discrimination, nuditity, vulgarity. Any submission containing such elements will be eliminated from the pool and not deemed eligible for judging.
